You should be able to control your car and stay on the track. It may be a good idea to practice for the before in the weeks before.

We want to have fair and funny races and expect, that every participant respects the other drivers and does not cause crashes on purpose. Of course, there will be crashes, please understand that mistakes happen, and we all learn with each race how to behave when racing with other people.

Rules:

1. **Fair Driving is required! These races are just for fun and to enjoy racing together.**
2. Be friendly with other drivers on the track:
 - Avoid "dive bombs".
 - No lane/line changes if another car is near to or behind you ("waving")
 - Moving under brake is forbidden
 - If 2 cars are entering a turn together, you must make sure that the other car always has enough space. The turn does not belong to one car, you have no right to move to the Apex middle of the turn or move to the outer line at the exit.
3. Use the "radar" (Helicorsa) to see where the competition is. If the radar is yellow or red, do not change lanes.
4. Blue flag: If the blue flag appears on the monitor or the display flashes blue, you must let pass the car behind you.

The rules will be explained in the lounge during the briefing before the start of the Qualification.
